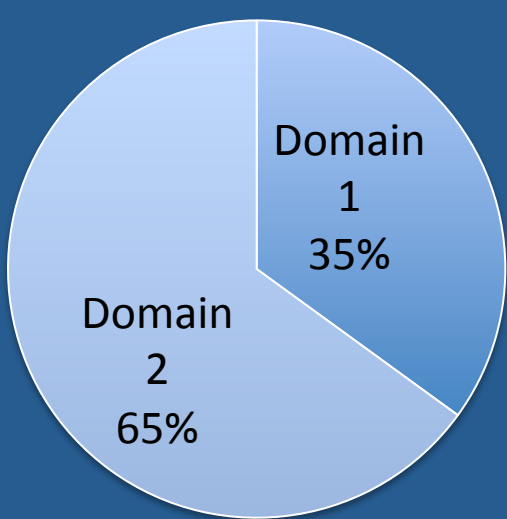

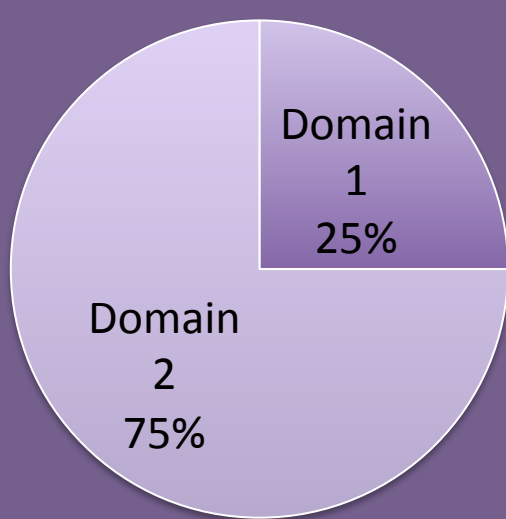

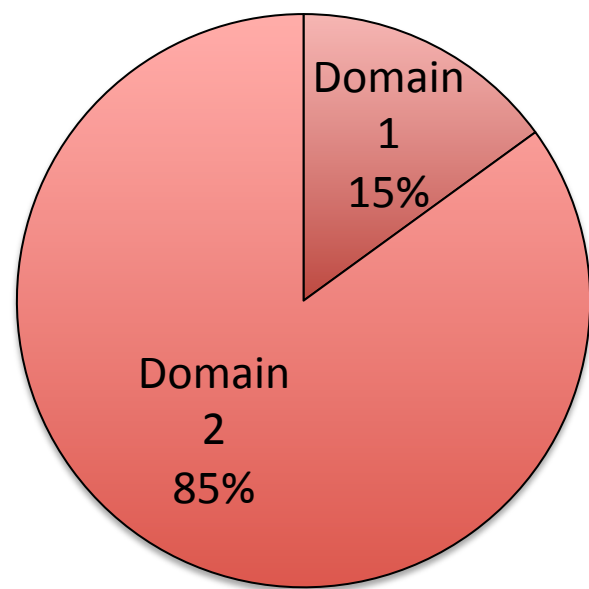

- ✧ Postoperative Sepsis
- ✧ Postoperative Wound Dehiscence
- ✧ Accidental Puncture or Laceration

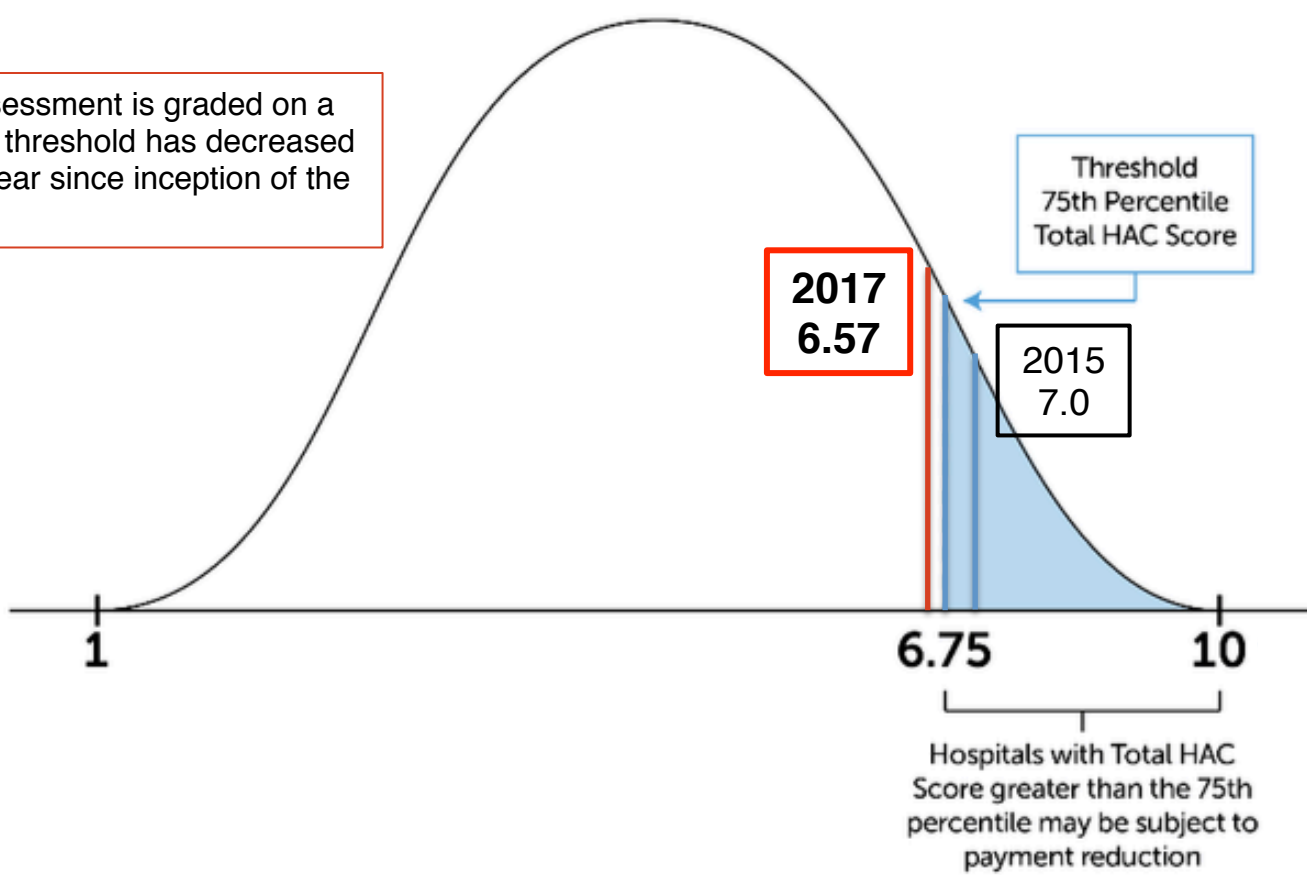
